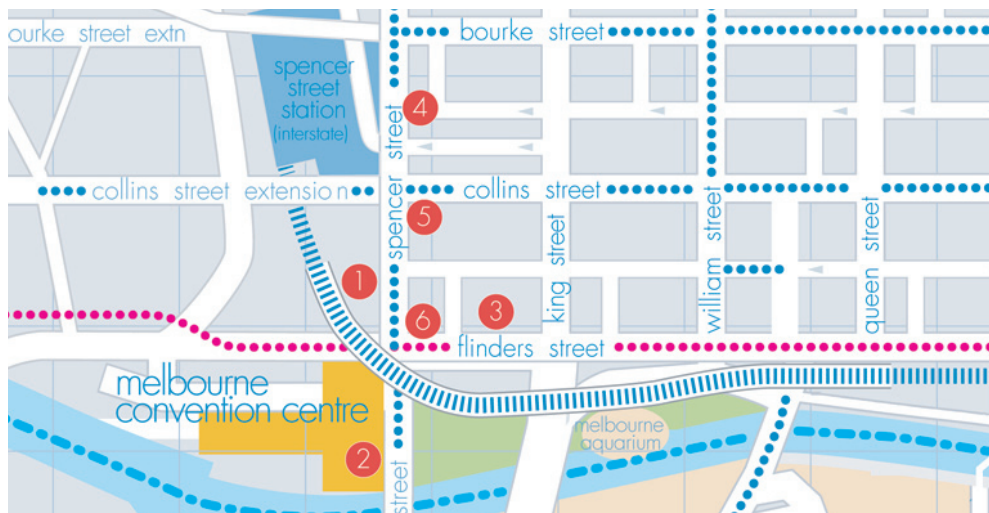

Melbourne Airport is approximately 22 kilometres from the Melbourne CBD – about a 30-minute drive, depending on traffic.

Getting there by taxi - taxis are available from the ground floor level of Melbourne Airport, outside both the International and Domestic Terminals. Expect to pay around AUD35 to AUD40 for the 30-minute trip into the centre of Melbourne.

Getting there by bus - Melbourne Airport is serviced by the state-of-the-art Skybus Super Shuttle, the only bus service linking the airport to the city. Tickets are available from the driver, from the information booth just outside the terminal or from the Skybus Super Shuttle website. Expect to pay AUD15 one way or AUD24 return. 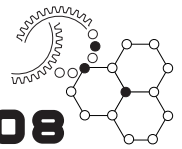
